

Consolidator Fellowship at the Historisches Kolleg for Applicants from the Global South

The Historisches Kolleg in Munich, an Institute for Advanced Study in History, is delighted to be able to advertise its first Consolidator Fellowship for the academic year 2025/26 that is specifically aimed at applicants from the Global South, especially from Africa. In cooperation with the Bavarian Academy of Sciences and Humanities in Munich (BAW), the Kolleg seeks to promote international cooperation and exchange and help counter structural inequality in academia across the globe.

The funds for the fellowship are generously provided by the Bavarian Academy of Sciences. The fellowship is open to applicants pursuing projects in the humanities, social sciences or the field of law that make use of historical methods.

The Historisches Kolleg is situated at Kaulbach Villa in Munich, located between the Bavarian State Library and the English Garden. Fellows are free from university teaching and administrative tasks and can fully concentrate on their research with the full support of the Kolleg's permanent staff. Fellows are required to be resident in Munich for the duration of their stay.

The fellowships are awarded by the Kolleg's board of trustees with the support of external expert advisors. Applications must be tendered by **30 April 2024**. All applications will be treated confidentially. All decisions are final.

In addition to full-year scholarships, the Historisches Kolleg offers Honorary Fellowships for shorter research stays. Further information can be found on the Kolleg homepage.
