THE HISTORISCHES KOLLEG WILL AWARD UP TO 7 FULL-YEAR FELLOWSHIPS FOR THE KOLLEG YEAR 2026/2027 (1 OCTOBER 2026 TO 30 SEPTEMBER 2027)

The Historisches Kolleg in Munich is an Institute for Advanced Study in History. Its grants allow scholars the freedom to concentrate on completing a book project.

Advanced Fellowships are aimed at established academics from all historical disciplines who are employed at universities or non-university research institutions and have demonstrated outstanding research achievements. These fellowships are intended to facilitate the completion of a major academic monograph.

Consolidator Fellowships are aimed at post-doctoral researchers in all historical disciplines. As a rule, they serve to facilitate the completion of a habilitation or a second monograph.

The Consolidator Fellowship Global South, advertised in parallel, is aimed at post-doctoral researchers, primarily from Africa.

The Historisches Kolleg is based in the Kaulbach Villa, located between the Bavarian State Library and the English Garden. Free from teaching and administrative duties, and supported by the Kolleg's staff, a stay there allows fellows to devote all their attention to an academic project. During their stay at the Historisches Kolleg, fellows are required to be resident in Munich.

Fellows are selected by the board of trustees of the Historisches Kolleg with the support of external expert advisors.

The application deadline is 30 April 2025. All applications will be treated confidentially. All decisions are final.
